

Pupil Premium Spending

Extra tuition - experienced staff members providing small group and 1-1 tuition to support targeted pupils and to raise standards (£140,248)

Parent intervention and support for vulnerable families (£34,398)

Additional Staff Training—Counselling, Listening Matters, Socially Speaking, Bereavement (£3,000)

Breakfast Club - free breakfast for vulnerable families and those children receiving early morning intervention (Staffing costs, equipment and food—£3750)

Subsidised school educational visits, theatre performances and holiday activities (£10,000)

Careers Fair (£500)

Safety Carousels and Neighbourhood Watch Schemes—Transport and attendance costs (£750)

Martin Gray Football Academy—Lunchtime Football Coaching to promote good behaviour and provide positive role model (£3880)

Provide positive opportunities (eg. Thrills and Skills Team Building) to promote citizenship and teamwork (£3,800)

Purchase of small outdoor play equipment to encourage physical activity and provide enjoyable play opportunities (£600)

Cooking Club to support and encourage healthy eating—staff costs and ingredients (£2380)

After school clubs and extended schools activities to raise self-esteem, develop skills and heighten aspirations (£15,000)

Organised play events—skipping and hoola hoop (£870)
