Maths

Task 1

 $2 \times 2 = 4$ so $4 \div 2 = 2$

Keep going and say them to yourself. Try jump counting or clapping to help you.

Task 2 Tables game

Use an A4 sheet of paper and divide it into 12 equal boxes, in each box write a multiplication calculation (but **not** the answer) for your chosen table in big numbers.

Next cut along the lines carefully. Once you have 12 cards read the calculation and write the answer on the back. (Use the facts you had already written out in task 1)

Place them all with the calculation facing up and now turn them over see how many you can answer correctly on your first try. Keep a tally of your scores.
