




Ask a grown-up to take you for a walk. Make it a nature trail and go hunting for different minibeasts. How many can you find? Maybe take some photos of them. We would love to see them.  How are the minibeasts the same? How are they different? What colour are they? Do they have wings? How many legs do they have?</p>

Can you count them all?  Try counting to 5 then 6,7,8,9 and 10.  Did you count all the way to ten?  Keep trying. You can do it! You will need: a piece of paper, a toilet roll tube, some scissors, glue (or sticky tape) and some felt pens or colouring pencils. Be very careful when cutting out! Have fun.</p>	<p><b>Expressive Arts and Design:</b>  <b>Focus: I can use what I have learnt about media and materials in original ways.</b></p> <p>Minibeast Biscuits.</p>  <p>Ask a grown-up to help you make some yummy minibeast biscuits. Here are some ideas. You will need: biscuits, icing sugar, jelly tots or smarties. Ask a grown-up to give you an old water bottle full of water. Outside, on your path or patio, try forming the letters in your name.  Rainbow writing - write your name.  Write your name in rainbow colours. Ask a grown-up to help you. Remember to use a capital letter at the beginning of your name.</p>
