We are pleased to inform you that an educational visit for Year 4 has been arranged for Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July. Both Year 4 classes will visit Seaham, as part of our Geography topic, 'What happens when the land meets the sea?'

This fieldwork visit has been designed to develop your child's knowledge of a range of fieldwork techniques and geographical skills. The unit prepares your child for their Geography learning in Y5 which focuses on the range of physical processes that shape the landscape.

We leave by coach at 9.15 a.m. and will return before the end of the school day. Children will need to wear school uniform, sturdy shoes, and to bring a waterproof coat, as we will be visiting rocky and sandy areas.

We will plan for all children bringing their own packed lunch for this visit, however, please let us know on the form below if your child requires a free school packed lunch. All children will need to bring a water bottle to the visit also.

We kindly ask for a parental contribution of £5 towards the cost of the coach, via Parent Pay. School is subsidising the remainder of the costs involved for this school visit.
